

# Motorcycle parking in the Lancaster district

## City Council Pay and Display Car Parks

Motor cycles are exempt from pay and display charges in any Lancaster City Council pay and display car park. Motor cycles can be parked in any parking bay except disabled bays and in other areas of the car parks provided they are not causing an obstruction.

Secure motor cycle parking facilities are also available in the following car parks:

Lancaster: Cable Street Car Park – near the main pedestrian exit into the city centre  
St Nicholas Arcades Car Park – facilities are available on both levels of the car park

Morecambe: Library Car Park – near the car park entrance and near the toilets  
Bus Station Car Park – near the bus station building

## Private Car Parks

Lancaster: Free parking is available at the Marketgate Shopping Centre Car Park – large area at the top of the entrance ramp and no chip coin is required. Press intercom to exit the car park after your stay.

Parksafe Car Park: Motorcycle parking is available in this guaranteed security car park which is open 24 hours 7 days per week. – normal charges apply.

For all other private car parks please check the information signs on the car park.

## Lancaster On-Street Pay and Display Parking (Lancashire County Council)

Motor cycles are **not** exempt from pay and display charges in on-street pay and display bays in Lancaster. Motor cycles are also subject to the maximum permitted stay and should refer to the time plate at each location for more information.

For on-street pay and display motorcyclists can also pay using the RingGo cashless parking option by telephoning 020 3046 0060 and registering free of charge for the RingGo service. Parking can then be purchased using the unique location code for each location. ## Lancaster City Centre

Please note that parking motor cycles is not permitted in the bicycle stands in Sir Simon's Arcade, Lower Church Street (outside St Nicholas Arcades Car Park) and on the traffic island in the north- west corner of Dalton Square. The alternative parking facilities listed above should be used.
