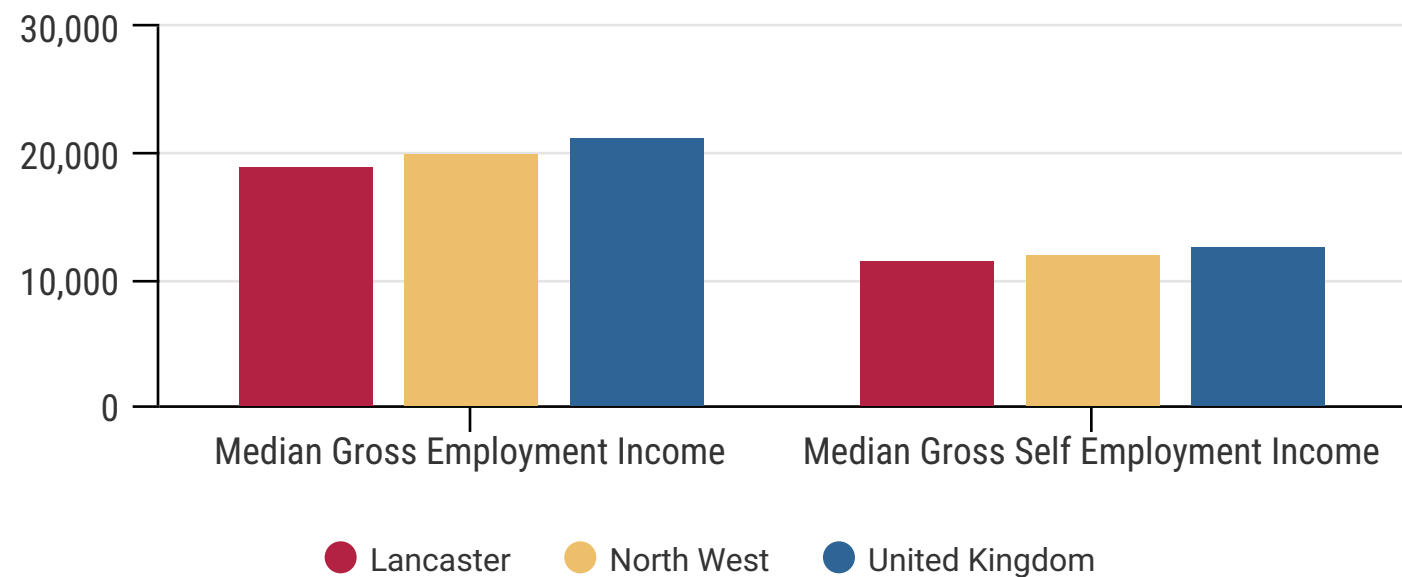

Top 5 Employment Types



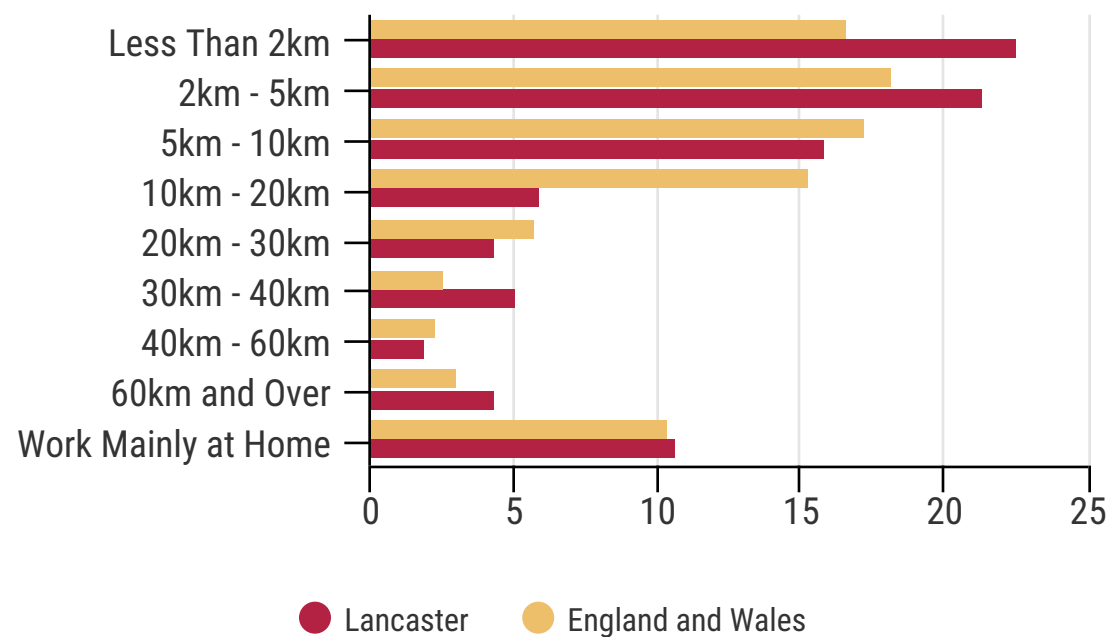

Distance Travelled to Work



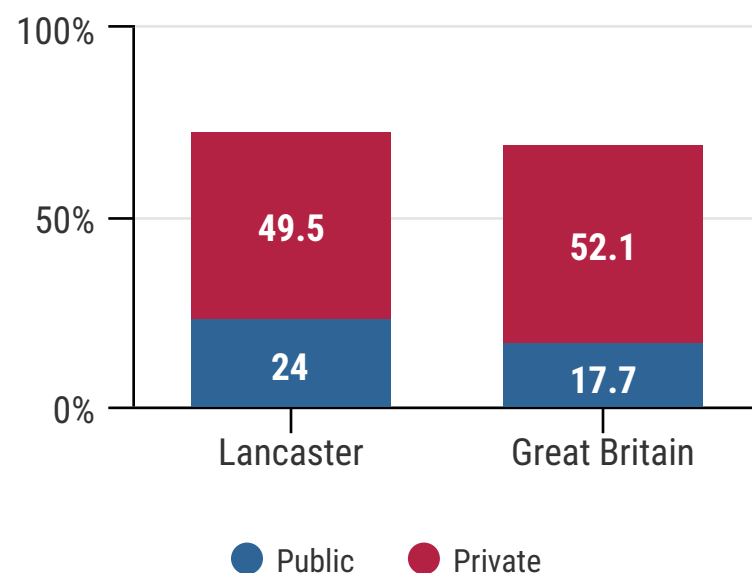
Lancaster has a high proportion of people **Travelling 60km or more to work** which would allow workers to reach Manchester

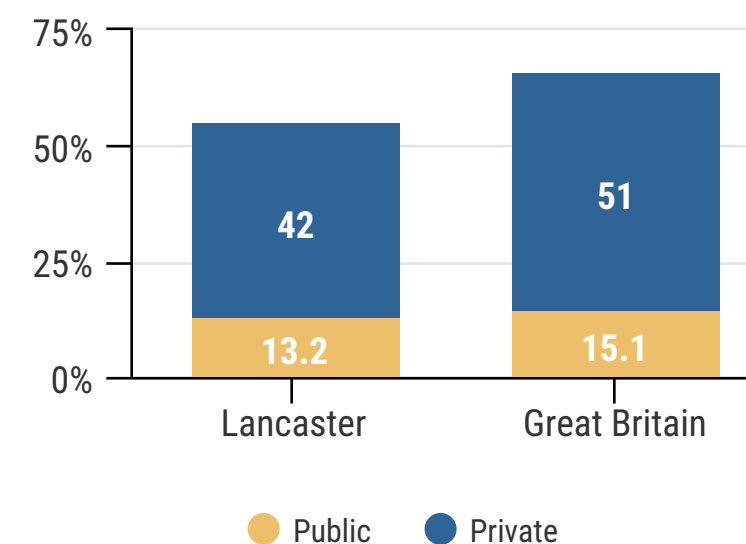
Number of jobs divided by population aged 16-64; this suggests a significant number of residents employed outside the district
