

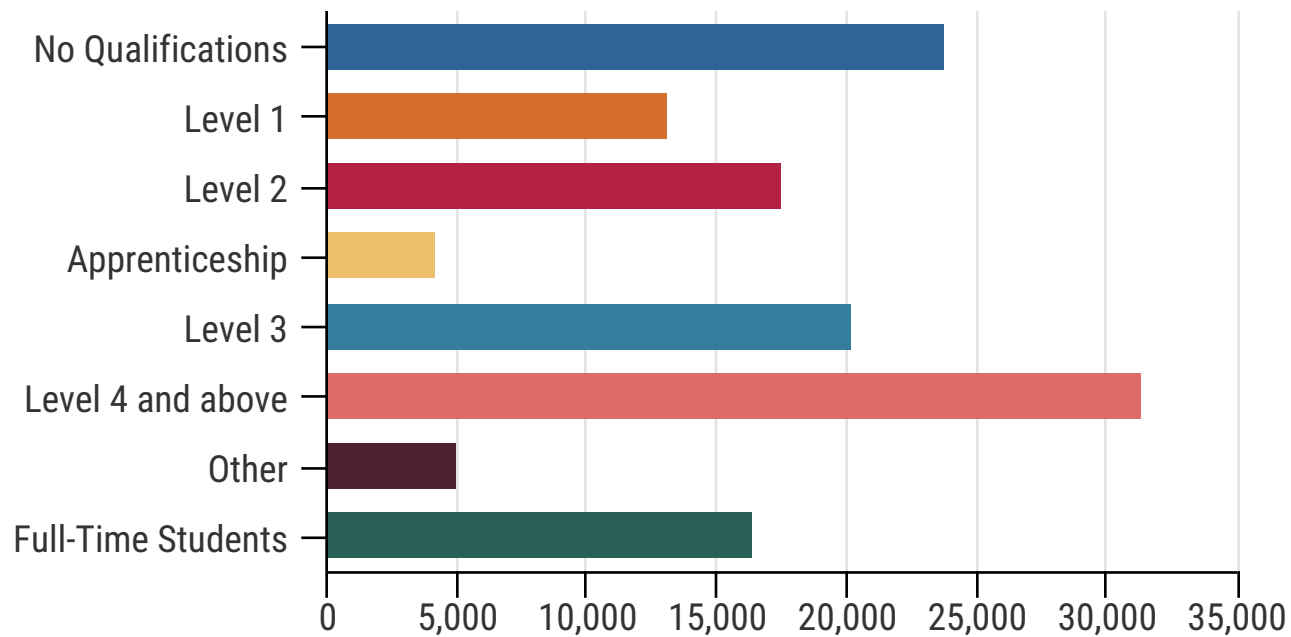

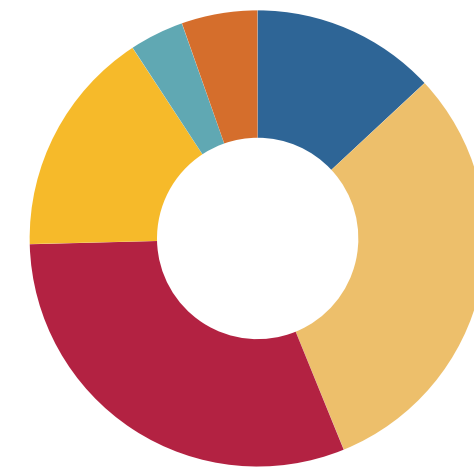

Non-White Ethnicity of Pupils

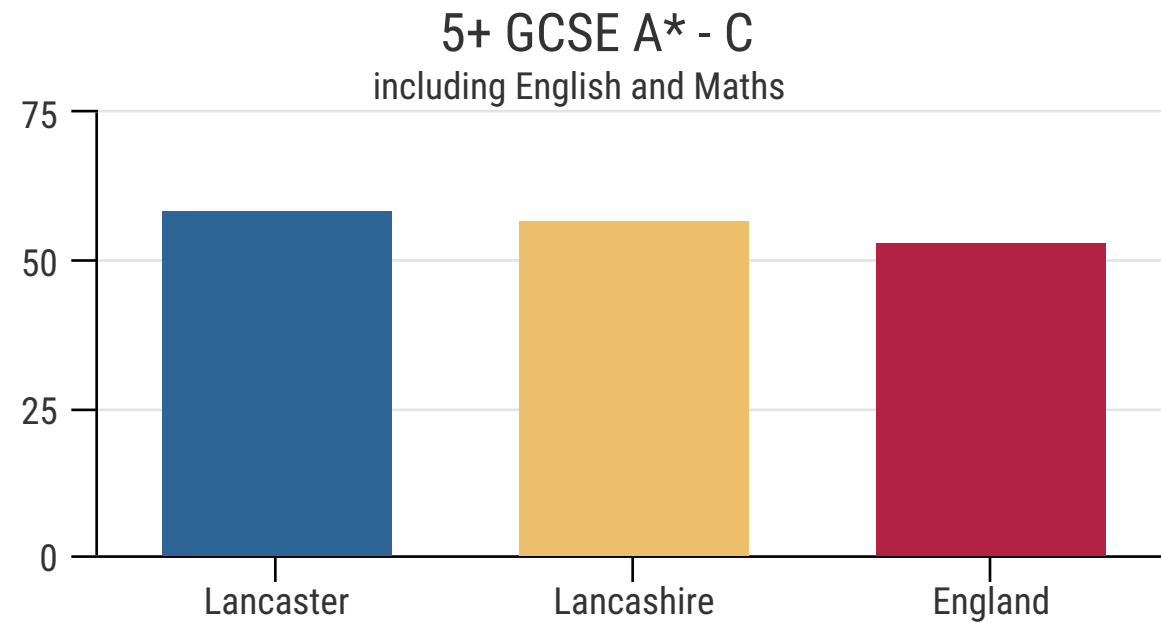

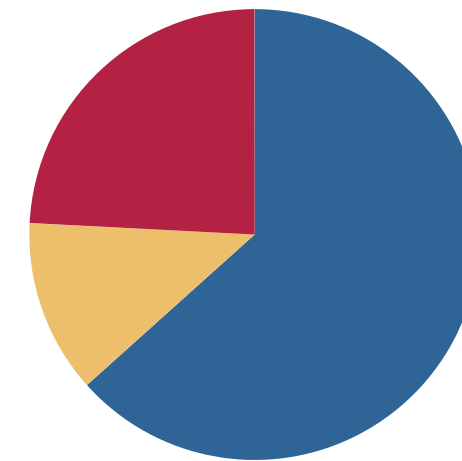


The district's **58.8%** of pupils achieving 5 or more Grade A* - C GCSE is **ahead of the average** for both Lancashire and England
