Bulky Matters - We can help you make space and you can help us help local people and the environment too!

Bulky Matters, a partnership between Lancaster City Council and local re-use and training charity Furniture Matters, can collect unwanted bulky household items from inside your home, at a time to suit you.

Items collected are re-used where possible, or recycled if they cannot be re-used whole, with only the residual waste going to landfill. Your re-usable items can provide training opportunities and help local disadvantaged people furnish their homes.

Collection times: Monday to Saturday, plus Tuesday and Thursday evenings. We guarantee to collect within 5 working days of you booking with us.

Collection cost: £20 for 1 item, £25 for 2 items, £30 for 3 or 4 items, then £8 for each additional item.

Wooden furniture - wardrobes, tables, chairs, sideboards, flat-packs, desks, bookcases, TV cabinets, wall units, etc

Soft furnishings - beds, settees, futons, easy chairs, headboards, cots, etc

Domestic appliances - washers, fridges, TVs, microwaves, DVD players, toasters, kettles, vacuum cleaners, lamps

Kitchen items - pots, pans, cutlery, etc

IT / Home Entertainment - TVs, DVDs, video recorders, computers, Hi-Fi units, speakers, phones, musical instruments, indoor toys and games, etc

Bicycles - adults and children's

Miscellaneous - gardening tools, outdoor play equipment, mobility aids, wheelchairs, bric-a-brac, etc.

Household fixtures & fittings - baths, sinks, toilets, fitted kitchens, worktops, doors, carpets, underlay, lino, etc

Outdoor items - rubble, bricks, fence panels, garden rubbish, black bags
