THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that Lancaster City Council, subject to approval of Lancashire County Council and the Chief Officer of Police, and in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33, 34 35, 35 (c), 39, 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order is to (1) Consolidate the City Council of Lancaster (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020 and sequence amendments (2) amend the City Council of Lancaster (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020's fees and charges, (2) Amend Plan 18 Battery Breakwater Morecambe, (3) Amend plan 31 Central Drive Morecambe, (4) Add Castle Grove permit car park, (5) Add electric vehicle charging tariff, (6) Add Lansil car park Lancaster and (7) Permit classes amendments.
