

Criteria for the assessment of Non-Designated Heritage Assets

VISUAL INTEREST

Does the site or feature contribute to the local character, architectural styles and building traditions?

- Product of intentional design
- Product of functional design
- Good example of a school of design or cultural movement
- High quality materials and/or craftsmanship
- Innovation in design or technology
- Of a locally typical appearance and/or materials
- Associated with an architect, designer or engineer of local or national significance
- Acquired a particular appearance as a result of later events, alterations or the patina of age which is of visual interest
- A local landmark/prominent in significant local views or vistas
- Has been famously captured by painters, photographers or writers
- Of visual interest as part of a group
- Other

HISTORIC INTEREST

Has the site or feature played a role in, or is it a well-preserved illustration of, aspects of local history?

- Agricultural settlements and activities
- Fishing settlements and activities
- Nonconformist religious movements
- The region's role in the Reformation of the church
- The region's role in the Industrial Revolution
- Georgian urban and cultural developments
- The region's role in maritime activities
- Victorian and Edwardian urban and cultural developments
- The region's role in the World Wars
- Post-War urban and cultural developments
- Developments in the history of healthcare and welfare provision
- Developments in transport and infrastructure
- The history of specific social groups or movements
- Retains associated fixtures, fittings, or setting(s) which enhance its historic interest
- Other

SOCIAL INTEREST

Does the site form a significant part of local or community identity?

- Featured in specific community activities
- Spiritual or religious associations or value
- Commemorative or memorial value
- Symbolic of a particular concept or event
