

Showaddywaddy -**50 Golden Years** 13th Oct, 7.30pm, £23.50

Long established as Europe's most successful ever exponents of retro-inspired rock & roll, SHOWADDYWADDY's record of achievements spanning 5 decades truly sets them apart from their contemporaries and their peers. The band's extraordinary voyage began back in 1973, when courtesy of an impromptu 'jam session,' the original eight man lineup chanced upon an instant musical chemistry, the likes of which immediately grabbed the small audience's attention, perhaps suggestive of things yet to come.

The music that filled the dancehalls during the Big Band era is brought to life again by The Moonlight Serenade Orchestra UK. Now in its 15th year, we welcome all! There will be dealers from all across the North of England selling stamps, postal history postcards and all sorts of relative items.




Dr Ben Garrod presents The Ultimate Dinosaur Show 24th Oct, 2pm, child/ concession £15, adult £17

His unique sound has been honed through a lifetime of concerts and recordings and performing with legends of the song and dance like Rafael Romero and Eva la Yerbabuena.



The Songs of The Drifters performed by Soul **Kinda Wonderful**

Soul Kinda Wonderful are the UK's No 1 Tribute to the legendary Drifters, award winners at the National Tribute awards 2013/2016/2017. Lead vocalist, Richie Sampson, has performed alongside former long standing members of The Drifters, such as Ray Lewis, Billy Lewis, Butch Leake and Roy Hemmings at various times.
