We're investing in your homes to keep them safe, modern, and energy efficient. Here's a breakdown of what work is planned and where.

Vale Estate

- **Kitchens:** 109 new kitchens, including sheltered bungalows and older homes across the estate. (More to come in future phases)
- **Bathrooms:** No separate bathroom programme this year, but some will be replaced if condition requires.
- **Doors & Security:** New entrance doors/screens and entry system upgrades to 5 blocks.
- Windows: Replacing old glazing in 109 bungalows.
- **Energy Upgrades:** Installing efficient electric heaters, solar panels, and insulation in selected homes.
- Re-roofing: Bronte House, Coleridge House.

Ryelands Estate

- **Doors:** Final phase of composite door replacements across the estate.
- **Next Up:** Once Ryelands is complete, door replacements move to Westgate Estate.

Kingsway

• **Garden Upgrades:** New fences, gates, and improved footpaths (no driveways/drop kerbs included).

Ocity Centre & Surrounding Areas

- **Fire Safety:** Smoke, heat, and CO alarms installed in 457 homes.
- **Secondary Glazing:** Window upgrades in conservation areas like Cable & Water Street, High & Middle Street, Castle Hill.
- Major Renovations: 10 older empty homes will be fully modernised and refurbished.

















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Across the District

- Energy Efficiency Upgrades: Targeting 105 homes with insulation, modern heating, solar panels, and more.
- Heating Upgrades: New boilers and heating systems where needed.
- Roofing: Full roof replacements at:
 - Ruskin House
 - Wordsworth House
 - Coleridge House
 - Bronte House

- Environmental Works: Upgrades to refuse storage areas in flat blocks.
- Electrical Safety: Rewiring and inspections in homes needing updates.
- Emergency Repairs: We've set aside a budget for unexpected urgent repairs.
- Property Conversions & Acquisitions: Buying or converting homes to expand housing availability.
