E. Notes

What is Second Adult Rebate?

Second Adult Rebate is a welfare benefit paid by the Council. It is designed to help people who are liable to pay Council Tax and who share their home with another person or persons on a low income. It can reduce a Council Tax bill by up to 25% and is designed to make up for the loss of a Council Tax single person discount caused by the presence of 'second adults' in the home.

Who can claim?

- People who are liable to pay the Council Tax and
- Who would not normally qualify for Council Tax Benefit because their income or capital is too high and
- Who share their home with a person or persons who have a low income.

Also, full-time students who share their home with another person or persons who are receiving Income Support, Jobseekers Allowance (income based) or Pension Credit can claim.

It is the person who is liable to pay the Council Tax that must claim the Second Adult Rebate

Who cannot claim?

You cannot claim this benefit if the other person that you share your home with is:

- Your spouse or partner unless they are a 'disregarded' person for Council Tax purposes. Disregarded people include full-time students, people who are severely mentally impaired, apprentices and prisoners.
- Under 18 years of age
- Paying you rent, or if anyone else in your home pays you rent
- A joint owner or joint tenant of the property.

What is the difference between Council Tax Benefit and Second Adult Rebate?

Council Tax Benefit is calculated using the income and personal circumstances of the person (and any partner) liable to pay the Council Tax. Second Adult Rebate is claimed by the person who is liable to pay the Council Tax but is calculated using the income of anyone else that lives with them (but see section "Who cannot claim").

Both benefits can be claimed but only one can be awarded. This form is to claim Second Adult Rebate only. If you want the Council to calculate Council Tax Benefit and Second Adult Rebate, you should complete form HB4 and you will be awarded the higher of the two benefits.

How is Second Adult Rebate calculated?

The benefit is calculated using the gross weekly income of the other adult or adults who are living with you. You must provide details of all the income received by the other adult(s). You are not required to state details of your own personal circumstances and income.

How much benefit will you get?

The amount depends on the gross weekly income of the other adult(s). The maximum Second Adult Rebate you can get is normally 25% of the full Council Tax bill before any discounts are taken off.

Students who can claim Second Adult Rebate (see section "Who can claim?") may get up to 100% of the full Council Tax bill paid.

How is the benefit paid?

If you are awarded this benefit, normally the amount you are entitled to will be deducted from your Council Tax bill.

Reporting changes of circumstance

As the applicant, you are responsible for informing the Benefits Team immediately if there is a change in your circumstances or the circumstances of anyone who lives with you which may affect your entitlement. For example:

- Any changes in a 'second adults' income
- If a 'second adult' starts or finishes employment
- If an adult joins or leaves your household
- If a child becomes 18.
