THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that Lancaster City Council, subject to approval of Lancashire County Council and the Chief Officer of Police, and in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33, 34 35, 35, 39, 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to create the City Council of Lancaster (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020.

The effect of the Order of 2020 is to (1) retain the existing provisions of the City Council of Lancaster (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (2) add the new car parks, (3) to introduce additional permit classes (Car Club, Pool Car, Rovers & Schools), (4) remove charges to Kingsway and replace with a maximum stay provision of three (3) hours, (5) introduce a 1 hour restriction to Rapid Charge Electric Vehicle places.
