

PAYING YOUR COUNCIL HOUSING RENT BY DIRECT DEBIT OR STANDING ORDER

DIRECT DEBIT

In the case of a direct debit the rent is claimed from your bank account on the 1st of each month. After setting up a Direct Debit you will be notified of any changes 14 days before they are due to take place.

The method for calculating your payment is as follows: Your weekly rent, multiplied by rent weeks payable (48), divided by monthly payments (12).

eg If your rent is £40.00 per week, the amount you would pay on a monthly basis is £160.00

STANDING ORDER

STANDING ORDERS ONLY

Do you want to pay weekly / fortnightly / monthly (Please cross out the ones you do not wish to use).

Payments can be set up to be taken from your Bank on a weekly, fortnightly, or monthly basis on the day or date that suits you best.

If there are any changes to the amount you should pay you will need to complete a new Standing Order Form.

The method for calculating your payment is as follows: Your weekly rent, multiplied by rent weeks payable (48), divided by the amount of payments, ie 52 for weekly payments, 26 for fortnightly payments and 12 for monthly payments.
