PROPOSED DIRECTION UNDER REGULATION 7 TO CONTROL

THE DISPLAY OF 'TO LET' BOARDS

Notice is hereby given that Lancaster City Council ("the Council") on 13th October 2020 made representations to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government requesting that he makes a Direction under Regulation 7 of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007 ("the 2007 Regulations") to restrict the display of temporary advertisements relating to the letting of residential premises, which are displayed on the land or premises to which they relate, within the wards of Bulk, Castle, John O'Gaunt, Marsh, Scotforth East and Scotforth West within the District of Lancaster.

The effect of a Direction under Regulation 7 of the 2007 Regulations would be to take away the deemed consent granted by Regulation 6 of the 2007 Regulations for temporary advertisements described in Class 3A in Part 1 of Schedule 3 to the 2007 Regulations in so far as it relates to temporary advertisements for the letting of residential premises. This would mean that no temporary advertisement signs for the letting of residential properties could be displayed on the land or premises within the prescribed area without the Council's express consent.
