THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER OFF STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2020 AMENDMENT ORDER No. 1 OF 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Lancaster City Council, subject to approval of Lancashire County Council and the Chief Officer of Police, and in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33, 34 35, 35 (c), 39, 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to amend the City Council of Lancaster (Off-Street Parking Places) 2020 Order.

The effect of the City Council of Lancaster (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020 Amendment No.1 Order of 2021 (the Order) is to add Central Drive car park Morecambe to the Order, remove Kingsway car park Lancaster from the Order and amend plan 6 of Windy Hill car park Lancaster.

The proposed additional car park and conditions is set out below: -
