Street works and road closure

Street works to improve Morecambe town centre started mid-February 2016. The section of Euston Road to Marine Road is almost complete and work has now commenced into Market Street to make 'Royalty Place'. These works will continue towards Market Street/Victoria Street in front of the Arndale centre.

Road closures in this area are necessary for the works on Market Street and Victoria Street and deliveries to Euston Road will be affected by the road closures. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via Central Drive - Market Street – Edward Street – Union Street – Victoria Street-Northumberland Street.



From noon on Monday 18th April the access to the loading bay (between The Arndale and Euston Road) will be closed. However, traffic will still be able to drive along Market Street and on to Victoria Street.

From noon on Monday 25th April, Market Street will be closed to through traffic to Victoria Street. Taxis will be moved to the bottom of Market Street near to the Library Car Park entrance and a new taxi bay will be in place on Tunstall Street (near Pedder Street Car Park). Road Closure

Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicles and cycles from proceeding over that length of Market Street, Morecambe from a point 40 metres North of the junction with Edward Street to its junction with Euston Road and a length of Victoria Street from its junction with Market Street to its Junction with Union Street.

For the duration of the works disabled parking will not be available on Market Street, however, additional designated disabled parking bays have been provided in the Library Car Park.

In addition to this, Lancaster City Council offers free and unlimited parking for disabled drivers displaying a valid Blue Badge in all of its offstreet pay and display car parks.

Marked delivery vehicles will be permitted to drop off on Market Street within the road closure depending on the area of works and the space available (lengthy delays may be experienced). Alternative locations for deliveries are loading bays on Tunstall Street and Derby Street.

Queen Street and Pedder Street
